The Date is Saturday October 3, 2020, and here is what to expect.

Visitors and Parking.

- Our visitor restrictions remain in place for the rest of the season: Only one visiting family is allowed per site per day. Please make every effort to preregister your visitors on the day they are expected. Be prepared with all names, full address, and phone number for your guests. Visitors must be from low risk states. Check Mass.Gov for daily updates.
- Please park any vehicles you can in the field across from the entrance during Halloween. This will help with safety during trick or treating. Please display your registration tag and take care not to block in other cars or the entrance.

Trick or Treating: October 3, 2020. 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

- Participation is up to you.
- If you wish to hand out candy, you must be the one to put the wrapped candy into the trick or treater's bag. No unattended bowls of candy.
- Tell your little ghouls and goblins not to eat their treats right away. They need to keep their fingers out of their mouths. Save all candy in a bag for a few days before eating to allow for a quarantine period.
- Everyone needs to thoroughly wash their hands after trick or treating. Masks required for the exchange of candy, both the trick or treater and the person handing out candy need to wear a mask.

Costume Parade and Contest.

- Due to restrictions on gathering size, sadly our costume parade and contest is canceled this year.

Trail Of Terror: October 3, 2020: What you should know.

- Our Spooky main event this year is a Trail of Terror!
- Warning: Our Trail Of Terror will be well, terrifying! Scary scenes will unfold as you walk with your guide along a trail 1/3 of a mile in length. This is not recommended for folks who scare easily or have mobility or visual problems.
- As parents or guardians it will be up to you to decide whether or not it is appropriate for your child. While there will be no physical contact from our actors, it can be quite frightening for some audiences
- Young children will not be allowed on the trail without a guardian. You will experience audio/visual disturbances, strobe lights, fog, or damp conditions.
- You may have your photograph taken.
- Please wear weather appropriate footwear and clothing.
- This event will run late into the evening. Everyone is required to wear a mask! If you do not want to wear a mask, please do not purchase a ticket.
- You must be wearing a mask to participate. If you do not have a mask, you will not be allowed on the trail, regardless if you have purchased a ticket.

- We will assign groups in the order we receive emails.
- This event will run late into the evening. Those wishing to be with an early group, please email us early in the week to purchase your tickets.
- There are 10 spots on each walk, that's it. We cannot squeeze more in, please do not ask.
- Each email can only purchase a maximum of 10 tickets.
- If you need more than 10 tickets send a separate email.
- If you want to walk with specific people order your tickets together.
- **There will be no refunds or exchanges. Your email must include everyone's full names and site number of each participant.**
- **Incomplete emails will be disregarded.**
- Contact us before 10/2/20 if you do not know your site number.
- Please only one walk per person. This event is run entirely by volunteers and we want to be respectful of their time and energy.
- Ticket Sales conclude Friday 10/2/20 at 8:00 pm. Any emails received after that will be disregarded.
- Tickets will be put in envelopes with your name, and can be picked up at the office no sooner than Saturday 10/3/20 beginning at 9:00 am.
- Please be prepared to pick up your tickets with CASH ONLY. Tickets are \$5.00 per person.
- Please this is a charity event, do not order tickets and then not purchase them.
- Deadline to pick up your tickets is Saturday 10/3/20 at 6:00 pm.

Trail Of Terror: The Event: Saturday October 3, 2020 8:15 pm to?

- Groups will be called at the pavilion and directed to wait at tables outside.
- Group one will begin at 8:15 pm.
- The next groups will be called in numerical order every ten minutes or so to be put on deck.
- As a rule each walk will take approximately 10 minutes. However, this is only an estimated time. It is your responsibility to pay attention to which walk is going to be next. Walks are called at the pavilion.
- Only when your group is called you will head to the field, meet your guide and wait to depart on your terrifying journey!
- We ask that you stay away until your walk number is called. Only when your walk number is called will you need to come to the field. It will help us avoid any confusion and help us keep everyone safe.
- Visitor hours do end at 10:00 pm, but they may stay longer if their group has not gone.
